The following results are the outcomes from the community survey carried out in April -May 2017 regards the Kalewater Community Company intention to purchase and develop the 4 acres of land next to the Templehall Hotel in Morebattle.

There were 389 survey forms with paid for return envelopes sent out to all addresses in the Kalewater Community Council area.

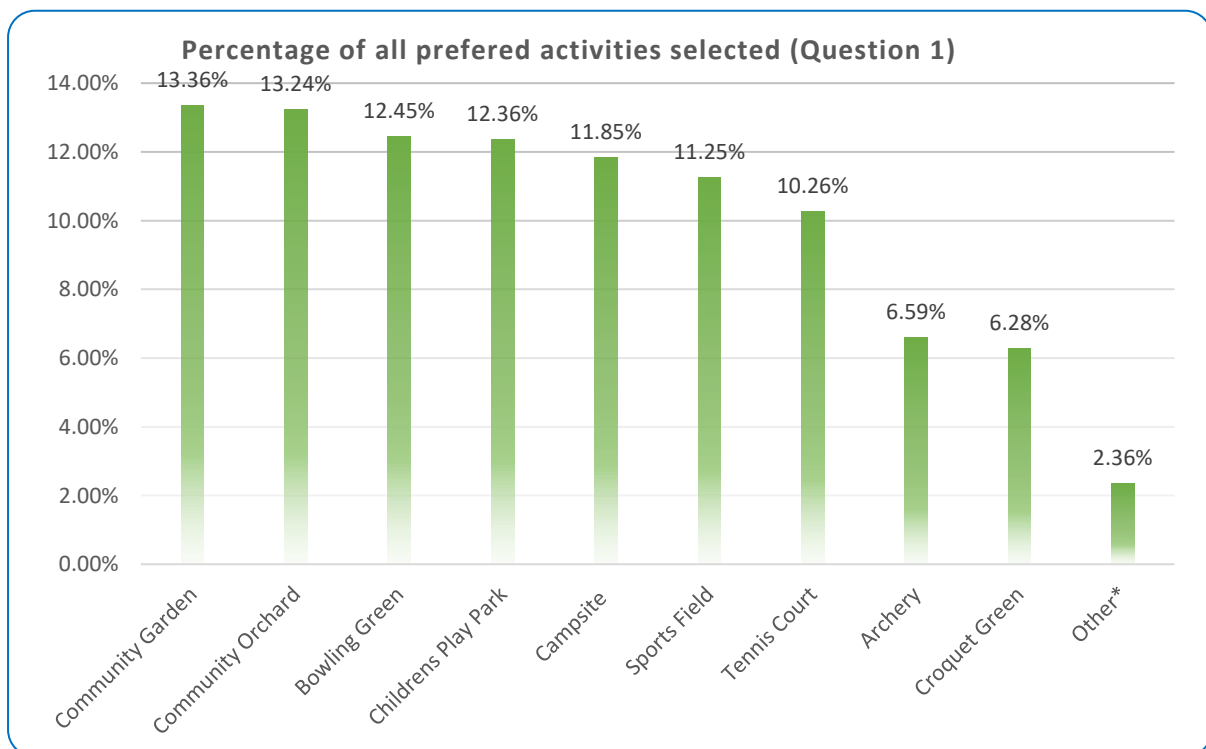
Of the 389 sent out 90 were returned completed the charts below show the results for all questions asked.

You were asked to select in order of preference with **1** being the preferred activity to **10** least preferred activity., The chart bellows converts the choices from all the returned forms into percentages.



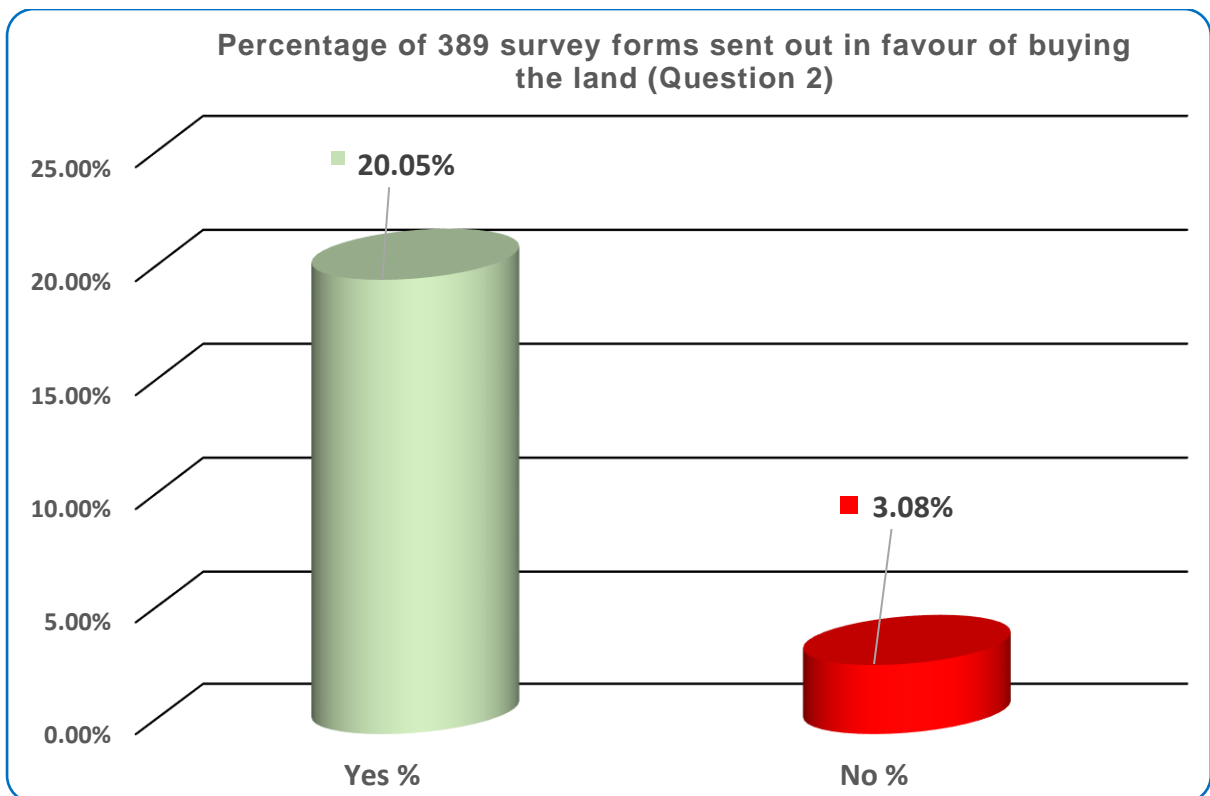
Below is a list of the **Other*** option 10 of Question 1

Allotments, not everyone has enough garden to grow their own vegetables and prices are going up! Excellent way of keeping fit/meeting people/sharing the produce.

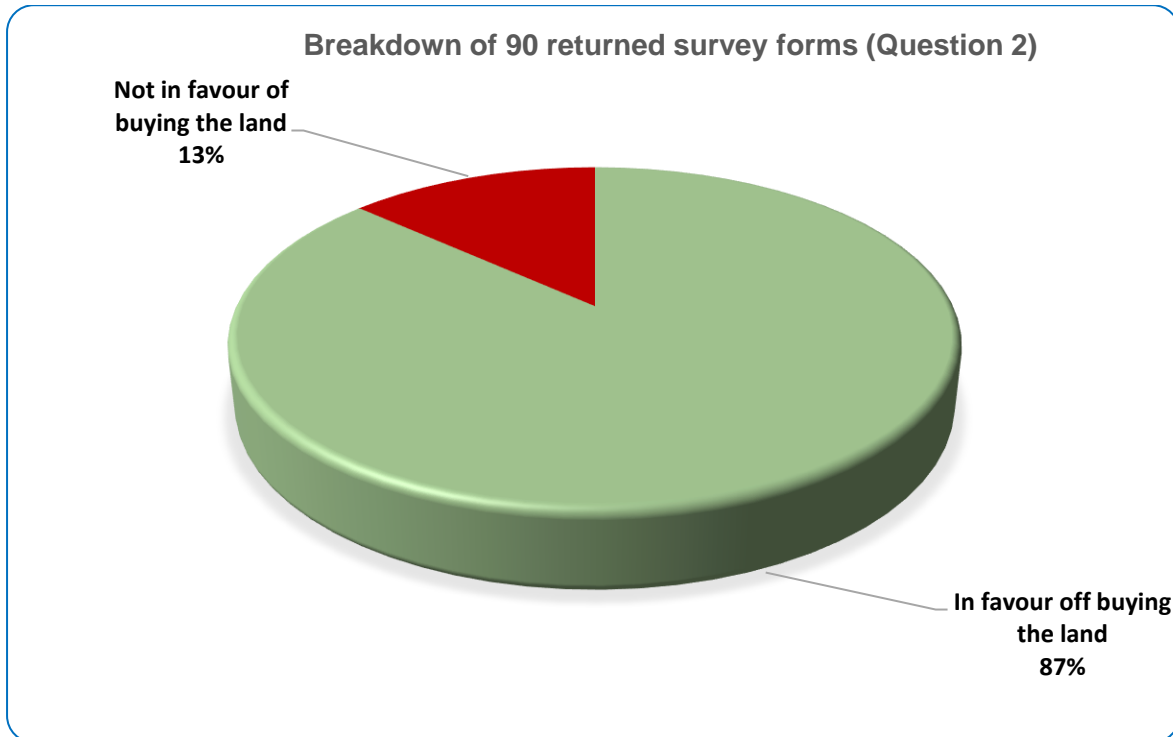

Do you support our intention to purchase and develop the land for the benefit of the community?



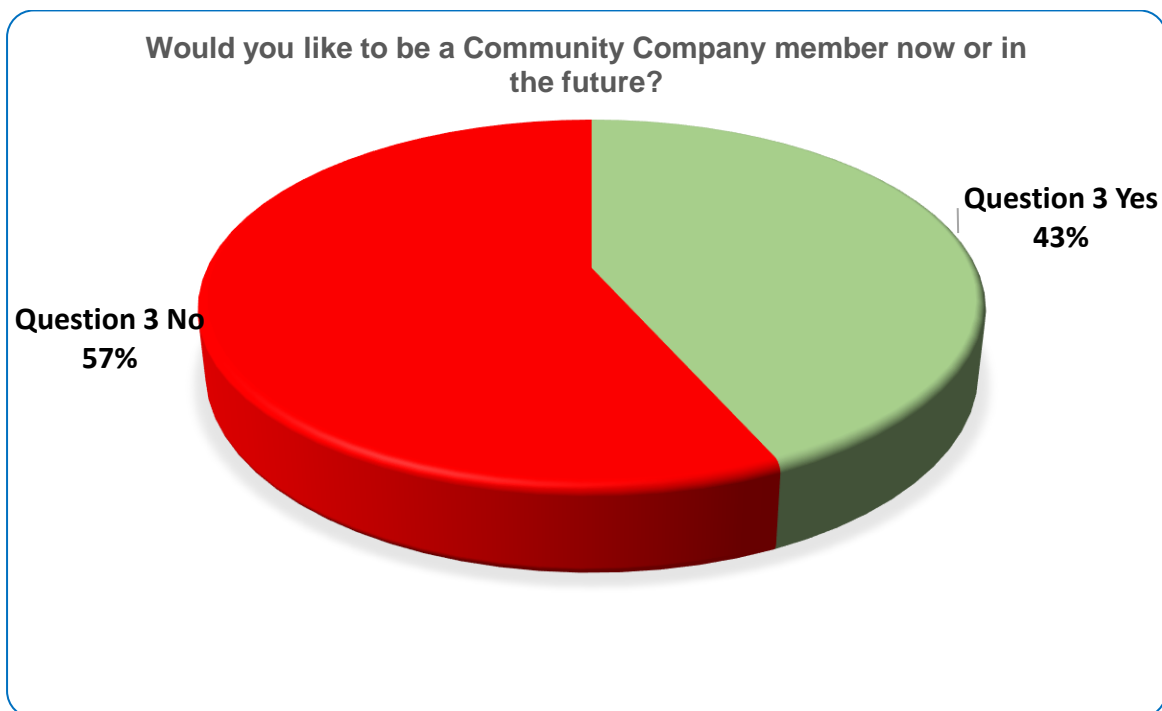

The following chart shows the percentages from all returned survey forms



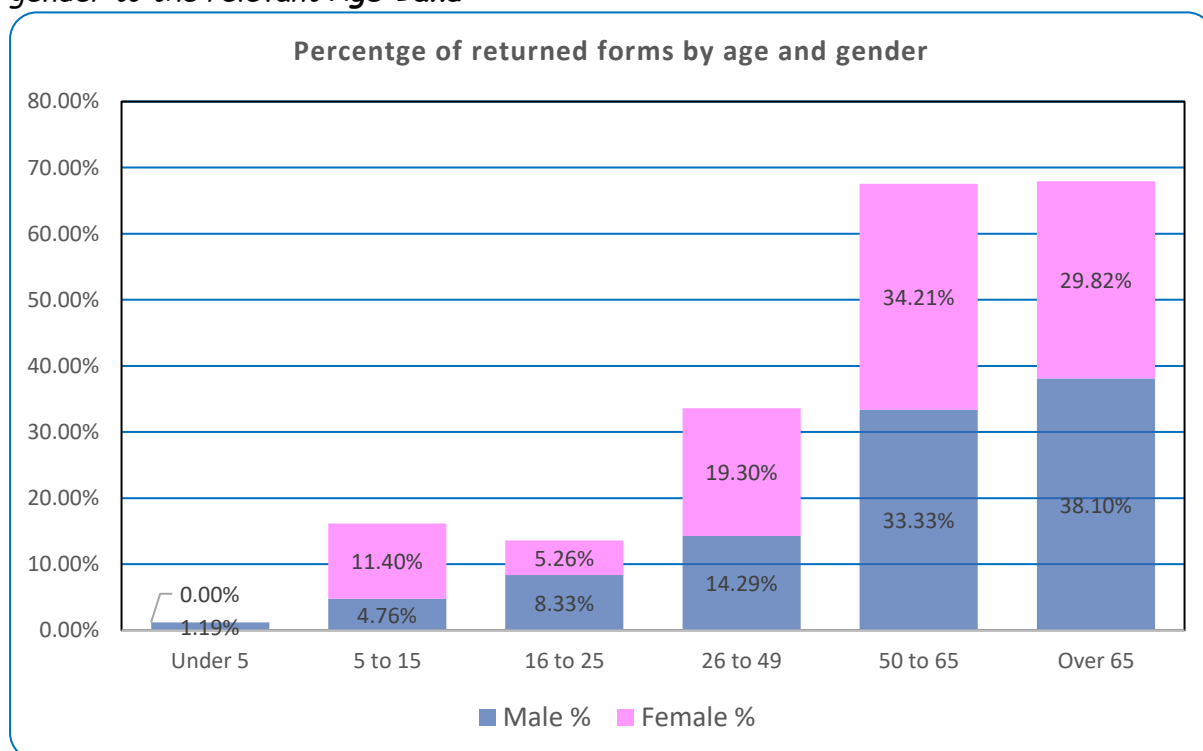
Question 3

<u>Community Garden</u> : Maintenance would be a problem struggle to get the volunteers at the moment.
The age of the community should be taken into account. A sports field could incorporate a lot of the other suggestions i.e.. Archery, tennis court. Etc.
Area with farm and walking area for disabled.
Money better spent developing field behind the school which would be used daily. The field behind school is used every school day and could be a lot better if money were spent on it - community would benefit too.

You make no mention of how much land is under consideration.
<u>Campsite</u> : with facilities.
<u>Campsite</u> : no thanks.
Totally object to any change of use and would like to see evidence that there is a need for this.
Morebattle has a history of failed projects!!! Bowls Football, Tennis Cricket to name some.
This village is in need for allotments as many people don't have big gardens or access to Pulmer's (parcels of land that some original villagers, these are right out of the village).
<u>Archery, Bowling Green Croquet green, tennis and Sports Field</u> : You have not given any indication on the size of the field. Big enough to use as main sports field replace existing one further away? Surely you don't want that.
